



HOW DOES PLAN INTERNATIONAL ECUADOR RESPOND TO COVID-19?

Reduce the impact of the COVID-19 crisis in coordination with humanitarian actors, public and private sector, through prevention of violence and humanitarian assistance for the most vulnerable communities, including migrants, refugees, and displaced individuals, prioritizing women and girls. Estimated scope: 1'500,000 people.

OUR ACTIONS

7-MONTH EMERGENCY PLAN RESULTS

- Donation of approximately 44,500 food kits and 8,000 hygiene supplies to 298,000 people.
- Reactivation of family orchards with the delivery of 955 garden kits and seeds to 3,000 people.
- Delivery of 1,662 scholarships to girls and boys in 8 provinces of the country. The scholarships included elementary school, middle school, high school, university and technology courses.

Prevention and response to violence, especially:

- Gender Based

- Development of informative material on menstrual hygiene distributed to 5,000 adolescents.
- Delivery of cash to 17,000 migrants and refugees.
- Installation of 35 sinks in markets, transportation stations and hospitals in Quito and Guayaquil to promote hygiene and prevent COVID-19.
- For this year's Girl's Day, the report on the state of the world's girls 2020: Free to be online? was launched. This report included research on online violence to more than 14,000 girls and young women from 31 countries, including Ecuador.
- Counseling 200 young people from the Girls' Movement through 20 online sessions to develop their digital strategy and to provide tools to respond to and face situations of violence, which, in turn, contributes to closing the digital gap. About 100 communication products were generated.
- Dissemination of educational communication campaigns on COVID-19 prevention, violence prevention, family solidarity and active parenting.
- Donation of supplies to entrepreneur women to support the production of more than 34,000 face masks in the provinces of Manabí, Loja, Santa Elena and Cotopaxi.
- Delivery of machinery to 300 women and men from 12 communities in the province of Loja to promote economic

empowerment.

 Virtual training on entrepreneurship and finance skills to 118 women and 48 men in Loja, Santa Elena and Cotopaxi.

- Donation of US \$1.7 million to CARE, ChildFund and Plan International by the "Por Todos" (For Everyone) Fund, managed by private companies.
- Participation in Government and UN discussion tables on issues of: security, food, education, communication, logistics, water and sanitation, migrants and refugees, protection and violence prevention.
- Presentation to the National Assembly of the study developed by Plan International and the Ministry of Education on Departments of Student Counseling as a contribution to the reform of the Organic Law of Intercultural Education.
